

Enrollment Guidelines

Kettering City School District

Parents or legal guardians of elementary and middle school-age students should register their child(ren) for classes at the school(s) that the child will be attending. A complete listing of school addresses and telephone numbers is available on the "Information for Prospective Residents" page on the district web site.

Parents or legal guardians of high school-age students should contact the Registrar's Office at Fairmont High School to schedule an appointment to register their child(ren) for classes. The Registrar's number is (937) 499-1611.

Students are eligible to enroll in Kindergarten

In the Kettering City School District:

- ✓ If they have reached their fifth birthday on or before September 30 of the year of entry; or
- ✓ If they have been approved for under-age admission; and
- ✓ If their parents or legal guardians live in the Kettering School District.

Students are eligible to enroll in the First Grade

In the Kettering City School District:

- ✓ If they have reached their sixth birthday on or before September 30 of the year of entry; and
- ✓ If they have successfully completed a full year of a state-approved kindergarten program; and
- ✓ If their parents or legal guardians live in the Kettering School District.

Students are eligible to enroll in all other grades, 2-12

In the Kettering City Schools District:

- ✓ If their legal guardians live in the Kettering School District; and
- ✓ If they have not been granted a high school diploma.
