AYP Result

Three-Year AYP Criteria
A district that misses AYP for three consecutive years; and that misses AYP in more than one student subgroup in the current school year; can be rated no higher than Continuous Improvement.

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Value Added Rating

A district rating can improve one level if the district exceeds expected gains for two consecutive years, or can decrease one level if expected gains are not achieved for three consecutive years.
