Motion 108-22 Approve Necessity to Levy a Tax

It was moved by Mrs. Kane, seconded by Mrs. Parks to approve the following resolution:

RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A
TAX AND REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO
CERTIFY MATTERS IN CONNECTION WITH A
PROPOSED TAX LEVY

(Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.03, 5705.21)

Current Operating Expense Levy

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the present and future requirements of the School District; and

WHEREAS, a resolution declaring the necessity of levying a tax outside the ten-mill limitation must be passed and certified to the County Auditor of Montgomery County in order to permit the Board to consider the levy of such a tax levy and must request that the County Auditor certify to the Board the total current tax valuation of the School District and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the tax levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Kettering City School District, Counties of Montgomery and Greene, Ohio (the "Board"), two-thirds of all of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

Section 1. The Board hereby declares that the amount of taxes which may be raised in the School District within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the School District.

Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5705.21 of the Ohio Revised Code, it is necessary to levy an additional tax for the purpose of current operating expenses in excess of the ten-mill limitation in the amount of 5.99 mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to \$0.599 for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, for a continuing period of time.

Section 3. The question of the adoption of a tax levy shall be submitted to the electors in the entire territory of the School District at the general election to be held therein on November 8, 2022. If approved by the electors, said tax levy shall be placed upon the 2022 tax list and duplicate, for first collection in calendar year 2023.

Section 4. The territory of the School District is located in Montgomery and Greene Counties, Ohio and the tax is to be levied on the entire territory of the School District.

Section 5. The Treasurer of this Board is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Auditor of Montgomery County and the Board of Elections of Montgomery and Greene Counties. This Board hereby requests that the County Auditor certify to this Board the total current tax valuation of the School District and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the tax levy if approved by the voters of the School District.

Section 6. All formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
