The Fred Von Gruenigen Scholarship Fund has been established to honor the best graduating Fairmont High School art student who will be pursuing a career in art or going to college.

The selected student will be presented a one-time grant of \$1,000. This grant cannot be renewed. The post high school pursuit by the selected student can be a career in art or attendance at a college, university or trade school of his or her choice. This award can be used for advanced education tuition, fees, room and board, books, supplies, and/or general living expenses. Should the student pursue an art career the award can be used for career pursuit expenses.

GUIDELINES:

1. Applicants must be graduating from Fairmont High School in the spring of 2011.
2. Applicants must be in good standing at Fairmont. They should have completed a minimum of 2 credit hours of Visual Art classes, earning a 3.00 average or higher in these classes. The student should be actively involved in art at Fairmont.
3. Applicants are responsible for submitting the application form and a digital portfolio of ten (10) original pieces of art. Entries must be received by April 11, 2011.
